Just a quick note so you know what is planned for this term.

Students have access to all of the teaching resources to support learning outside of the classroom through student POD. Please ask that they show you this and find out where they are up to in each subject. Information on every end of year/key stage assessment is also available on POD.

We will be continuing the work with students to help them get organised in terms of prior reading, self-study, revision, time management, locating and using resources, and independence. I'll be in touch as we do this so it can be reinforced at home too. To help with this, all students will get a set of knowledge organisers this week. Again, if you can ask to see them and talk to your child about what they are learning and practice knowledge recall, it is very helpful to them. These are also available here:

Some other reminders;


- Students can replenish pencil cases with equipment that they can buy with 'merits' in the LRC.
