

Recycling Officer

What is it?

A Recycling Officer is responsible for promoting and managing recycling schemes to reduce waste and encourage sustainable practices. They work with local councils, businesses, and communities to implement and improve recycling initiatives.

Qualifications/Experience Required:

A degree in environmental science, waste management, or a related field is beneficial. Experience in environmental work, local government, or waste management is advantageous. Knowledge of environmental regulations and waste reduction strategies. Strong communication and organisational skills.

What the Work Involves:

- Developing and managing recycling and waste reduction programmes.
- Educating the public, businesses, and schools about recycling practices.
- Monitoring waste disposal and ensuring compliance with environmental laws.
- Working with councils and waste management companies to improve recycling rates.
