Engage with the KS5 work that these providers are publishing – it will give you an advantage when your course begins.



Familiarise yourself with the course content and specifications that you will be studying.



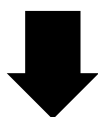
Be proactive. If you have any questions, contact your chosen provider or Ms McManus.



Attend the virtual events that are being advertised – these give you the opportunity to speak with teachers and this is invaluable.



READ! Your chosen providers will have recommended reading lists for your courses; work your way through these.



Keep checking your school email – Ms McManus is forwarding any information that she receives.



Keep studying. Contact the teachers of the subjects that you are intending on studying at KS5 – they can offer guidance, subject-specific tips and point you in the direction of higher level material to keep you occupied.



Speak to your peers. They may have found websites or other online material that you could benefit from.
