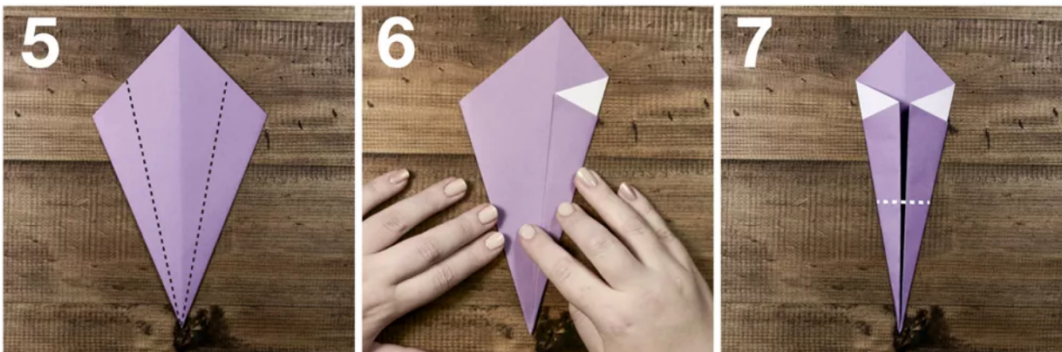
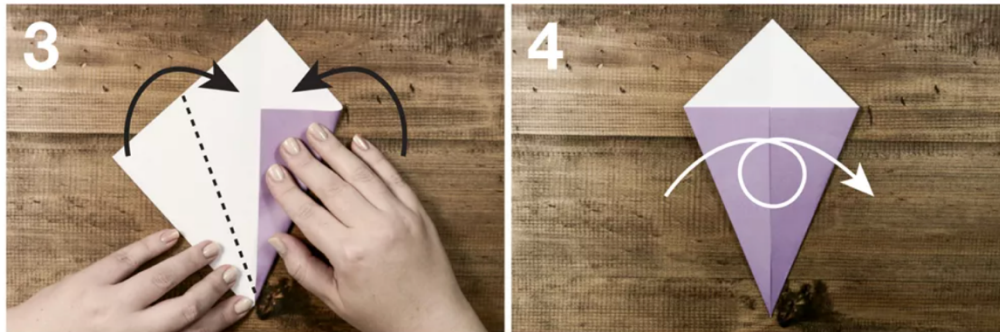
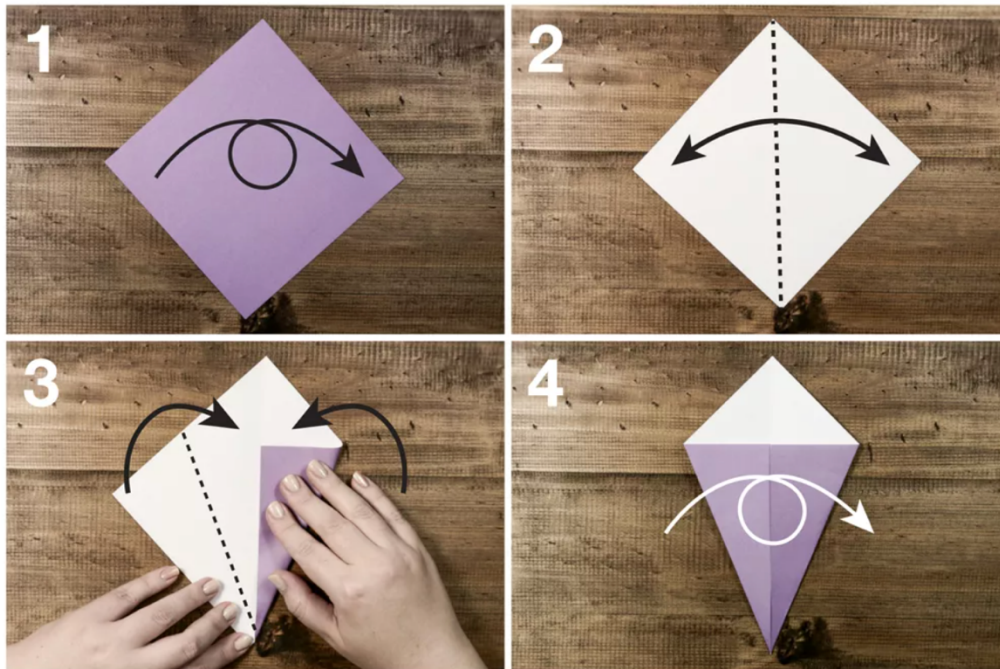
1. Easier - Origami spring flowers - Tulips

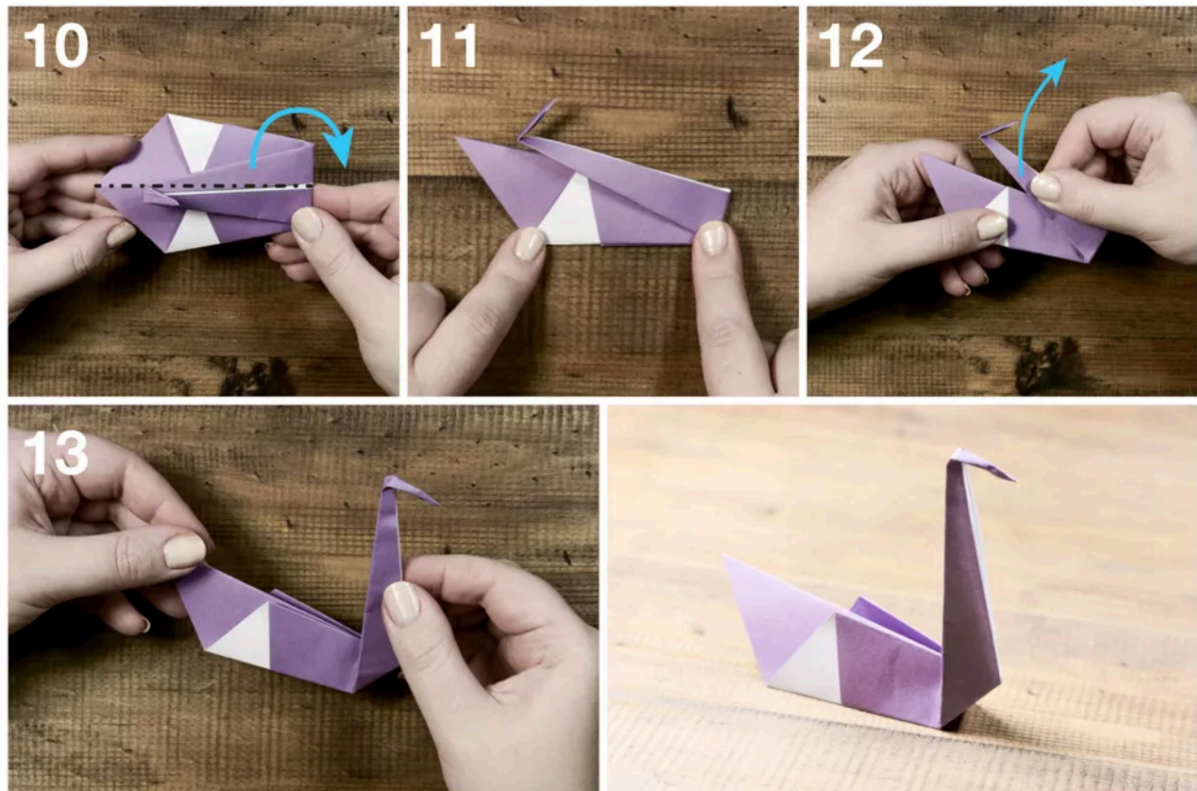

One swan was too easy?

- Accuracy trial: When you've made one swan try to make five identical swans take real care with your paper folding.
- Speed trial: time how long it takes for you to make a swan. You can investigate whether you can be fast and accurate at the same time.

Link to STEM- Astronauts do you have what it takes?

An astronaut selection programme is very competitive and potential applicants are tested in several ways to find the perfect person for the job. Origami was a test devised by the Japanese Space Agency. Applicants have one hour to make as many perfect paper birds as possible. This task is key to assessing an applicant's attention to detail, even when faced with an intricate or repetitive task.
