Targets and Grades

- Students in Year 9 receive an updated target grade from grade scale based on prior attainment.
- Grade scale - 1f, 1e, 1d, 1c, 1b, 1a, 2c, 2b, 2a, 3c, 3b, 3a, 4c, 4b, 4a, 5c, 5b, 5a
- Student undertakes 3 assessments, 1 each term.
- Assessments are graded using the grades above.
- Results are recorded on reports
- Students should begin to make progress towards target grade. The 3 columns on the report indicate whether progress is being made.
- By the end of the academic year the majority of students reach their target grade.
- At the beginning of year 10 the target grade changes to a GCSE target as students head along the pathway towards their end of key stage 4 grade.

The report is divided up in to following areas, identified by the numbered dots.

- In this column you will find the subject your child studies.
- This column is your child's end of year target. It is calculated from prior attainment
- and 4 - These columns show your child's attitude towards learning and their homework effort in each subject.
- The current grade that your child is working at. The grade scale for your child is 1f, 1e, 1d, 1c, 1b, 1a, 2c, 2b, 2a, 3c, 3b, 3a, 4c, 4b, 4a, 5c, 5b, 5a, With 1f being the lowest and 5 being the highest.
- This shows your child's progress in each subject. This is calculated by comparing their current grade and how far it is from achieving their target grade.
- We report this 3 times per year. (assessment schedule)
- The report key - what each colour and number represents.
- Shows your child's attendance to date, the number of merits awarded and the number of detentions they have been set from the beginning of the year.
- Attendance per term.
